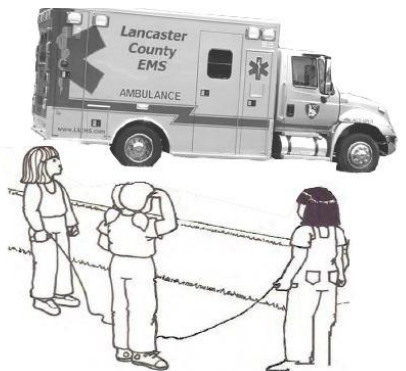

The care that is offered by Lancaster County EMS will be made as pleasant as possible, and delivered in a courteous, prompt and caring manner. Teach your child to use 911 when emergencies happen.

“Watch From A Safe Place”

- Never approach the scene of an emergency. Stay behind the side walk. NEVER run into the street to look at an ambulance.
- When in a car and you see an ambulance coming with its lights and sirens on ask the driver to safely pull off to the right.
- When approaching accident on the roadway remember to move over for EMS, Fire, and Law. Safely move to lane furthest away from the accident.
